HIGH GLOSS RESIN FINISH ON WOOD TECHNIQUE Decoupage technique with a two part resin waterproof finish on a small tray or similar surface	R185	SERVIETTE MINI TRIO Learn to decoupage serviettes on three surfaces such as stone, fabric, wood, plastic, terracotta using appropriate mediums	R175
CLOCK PROJECT Decoupage technique to create wall clock or CD clock on stand with numerals & mechanism included	R185	ON GLASS DECOUPAGE TECHNIQUE Mulberry paper & serviettes with beading on an ordinary vase shaped glass to create a candle light	R170
ENAMEL DECOUPAGE Decoupage technique to decorate an enamel bowl/plate using paper/serviettes paints and varnishes.	R185	WRAP-AROUND DECOUPAGE New look – less paint – cover entire sides of wooden box with paper	R185
UNDER GLASS DECOUPAGE TECHNIQUE Covers cutting, painting and sealing under glass to create a fully washable item. Make a small 20 cm plate/bowl.	R185
